

Priority audio-visual learning aid development (PRJ-0169-2017) SAMPRO (Training)

Quarter 4 2017 (October 2017 till December 2017)

Project goals

Goal 1 - Development of two DVDs on laboratory practices for Milk Reception analyses as training aids

Achievements

- 1. Priority was awarded to the development of two DVD resources (audio-visual) encompassing the tests conducted on milk mainly but not exclusively at the stage of milk reception from bulk tankers. These tests are:
- 1.1. Temperature determination
- 1.2. Alizarol test for protein stability and acid development/alkaline contamination
- 1.3. Resazurin test for microbial activity
- 1.4. pH determination as indication of acid development/freshness
- 1.5. Titratable acidity as alternative method for detrmining acid development/freshness
- 1.6. Determining the presence or absence of antibiotics
- 1.7. Determination of added water by freezing point evaluation
- 1.8. Gross composition via Infrared (IR) analysis
- 1.9. Fat% determination via the Gerber method
- 2. A consultant previously used by roleplayers in the Dairy Industry was contracted and planning was presented by way of:
- 2.1. Arrangement of access to a dedicated laboratory within the dairy industry
- 2.2. Recording guide, indicating the envisaged and expected scenery and performances to be recorded
- 2.3. Full script of narration to serve as audio component, including graphics to be used for explaining concepts
- 3. All necessary filming was performed with the Project Manager enacting the role of film director on-site.
- 3.1 All recordings made were checked by the Project Manager for suitability
- 3.2 All narration was performed by the Project Manager and co-ordinated with the video, graphics and stills photography footage.
- 3.3 The final product was shown to the host dairy processor (as agreed upon prior to release), who expressed their satisfaction with the result.
