Project goals

Goal 3 - Ensure appropriate and timely (before set deadlines) inputs by SANCIDF and SA representatives on IDF bodies to IDF

Achievements

The following two questionnaires were received from IDF:
Questionnaire 0321/SCMH- Inventory of Microbial Food Cultures with safety demonstration in fermented food products. Revision of the 2018 published rationale and available taxonomic updates in order to update the inventory of microbial food cultures. Simultaneously, a questionnaire was sent to all IDF National Committees for submission of new species based on the published scientific rationale. Approval is requested for the publication of the attached papers as a bulletin of the IDF

Questionnaire 0421/SCDST_SCMH- Heat Treatments of Milk, Approval is requested for publication of the Bulletin.

Questionnaire 0521/SCAMC - Milk, dried milk products and cream — Determination of fat content – Gravimetric method for Standard ISO/DIS 23318|IDF 249/2021

SANCIDF replied positively to all three questionnaires
