Project goals

Extensive deliberation in respect of the draft R3337/ 2023. Regulations relating to the labelling and advertising of foodstuffs. R1510/2019 Regulations relating to dairy and imitation dairy products. SANS 1694 Welfare of Dairy Cattle and SANS1448 Transport of Livestock took place during the third guarter. Actions included industry consultations and submission of comments and draft proposals on behalf of the organised dairy industry.
