Project goals

Goal 1 - To maintain membership of IDF by paying the membership fees of IDF and IMP before 31 March 2024 at the best possible exchange rates

Achievements

The SA National Committee of IDF has to pay the fee as determined by IDF. The full membership fee for 2024 as determined by IDF in October 2023 was €44 500 (August 2023 expected fee was €43 150) was paid on 19 January 2024 at Rand value of R 927 325. South Africa is also a full member of the International Milk Promotion (IMP) group and its separate membership fee, is €1 220 at Rand value of R 21 022

Goal 2 - Review SA representatives on IDF bodies (SC'S, AT'S etc.) so that the best-qualified persons can represent SA on these bodies

Ms. Chané Pretorius from the Dairy Standards Agency was appointed on the Standing Committee (Standing Committee of Microbiological Hygiene and Ms. Marieke Maree, a project leader on Milk SA's R&D program was appointed on both Standing Committee Environment and Standing Committee Marketing.

New Work Items (NWI)

IDF always proposes its New Work Items (NWI's) for the year to their members in the first quarter of each year. For 2024 they proposed eight NWI's of which SA supported 2 NWI's and nominated 2 local persons on the task forces that will handle the NWI's. IDF adopted the following 8 NWI's for 2023.:

NWI 24/02: IDF Dairy Cattle Welfare Forum (Dr. Mark Chimes nominated to the AT)

NWI 24/03: Determination of proteins in milk fat globule membrane in infant milk formula and other dairy products.
