Project goals

Achievements

The SA National Committee of IDF has to pay the fee as determined by IDF. The full membership fee for 2024 as determined by IDF in October 2024 was €45 600 (August 2024 expected fee was €45 390) was paid on 17 January 2025 at Rand value of R 879 711. South Africa is also a full member of the International Milk Promotion (IMP) group and its separate membership fee, is €1 025 at Rand value of R 20 093
